Anneliese Hackmann President of the WCF Germany:

Ring 1 All breeds

At time of my birth in my family lived a white Persian tomcat. But, how it was usual in formerly times, he was given away when I was born, although my mother was fascinated of white Persians. I remember that during my school time also a white Persian was



our favourite. Later we had many different other domestic animals.

The first own Persians I bought on a cat exhibition was a blue-cream Persian-girl. I didn't want to breed at that time. Many years later I started breeding. But on this way I became acquainted with the "cat scene".

First I bred Persians, then in addition Siamese and Oriental Shorthair. A breeder, who lived in the former German Democratic Republic, asked me for buying one Birman in France for him. I did it! However I was immediately so fascinated by this cat, which was almost one-year old that time that I kept it by myself. Instead of that cat I gave the breeder a nice kitten. That was the beginning of my Birman breeding. I bred Birman for many years, and I did it with great pleasure.

My last breed was the German Rex. I became acquainted with the breed when my husband fetched some cats at the airport which couldn't travel to USA. Of course I looked for a new home for the poor cats. But I kept some of them by myself because I was so attracted by the kindness and the wonderful characteristics of the German Rex Now I am judging already since more than 30 years. I am All breed Judge. Through this activity I became acquainted with almost the whole world. Some years ago, when I couldn't exhibit my cats anymore, because they had reached all titles which were possible, I got more time and my life was getting a little boring. Therefore I accepted a function in the "Cat scene". First I was member in the German cat federation "1. DEKZV" and fulfilled some tasks up to the Vice President. In FIFé I worked for several years as chairman of the judges and the disciplinary commission at the same time. Sometime later I left the club and the organization.

I decided to set up a new club named "Deutsche Edelkatze", which is a member of WCF. I am still president of this club. 26 years ago I founded the World Cat Federation (WCF) in Rio de Jainero. Here I am the president since the founding. Together with Alva Uddin from FIFé and others, I was one of the founders of the World Cat Congress (WCC) in

Additionally I wrote some books, the most successful one about Birman. I was working at some Video Production and I worked at the preparation of a german CD-Rom with the title "All about cats".

I believe those ones were the most important stops of my "CAT-LIFE". I do not breed anymore because I am too much travelling and have too little time because of my different tasks in the associations which I must process.

I brought my first cat to the home of my aunt when I was 9 years old. He was found in the heating unit of a public building and 6 weeks old. As he lost his family very young "Max" was not very well socialised with other cats, but lived a

happy life for 24 years with my aunt and her family.

My first breed were Persians in bicolour and colourpoint, I bred Siamese and Orientals, British Shorthairs and Bengal cats.


Whenever I am asked: which breed do I prefer, I say, there is no breed I prefer. It is the beauty of every single cat, the gentle soul and the wonderful sweetness in their eyes that makes me love every single cat, no matter which breed it belongs to.

My biggest project in the past was the saving of the natural breed of Cyprus, the Aphrodite. In the beginning it was not the idea to produce a new breed. The project was meant to help installing a law for the protection of cats in Cyprus.

Today the Aphrodite's are recognized in WCF e.V. and other World Cat Congress members.

I am a judge since 1992, AL breed judge since 1996, in WCF e.V. From 2007. Member of Disciplinary commission (2009), and 2012 elected Secretary General of WCF.

My biggest wish is to move things for the benefit of cats in particular and in general. And I see the biggest potential in the WCF and WCC and its members to work hand in hand for a bright and beautiful future of our loved cats.
